Principal's Message

Dear MacArthur Families,

The purpose of Fall Conferences is to **connect** and **create partnerships** with families to support students in academic and social-emotional growth and create realistic goals for next steps in social-emotional, participation, and academics. Fall Conferences are scheduled on **Monday, November 2, 2020** through **Monday, November 9, 2020.**

Communication is key and I want to encourage parents and guardians to take this time to share your ideas, thoughts, and concerns. We want to know more about how to support your child and your families. What motivates your child? How are they adjusting to the current way of learning and living? What is your challenge and how can we help you? Teachers will also take this time to share your child's strengths, progress towards the standards, and areas for growth.

Our School Site Council Committee revised the **Home School Compact** for 2020 - 2021 which describes our collaborative commitment to ensure the success of all students:

Home School Compact 2020 - 2021

MacArthur School Staff will:

- Provide an academic program that is rigorous and challenging for all students.
- Be positive role models for students.
- Communicate on a regular basis regarding the academic progress of your student.
- Provide opportunities for parents to be involved in school activities supporting student achievement including parent conferences, volunteers in the classroom (VIPS), observations and school governance.
- Provide resources and educational materials that reinforces reading, writing, and math skills.
- Engage students in social emotional learning (SEL) by introducing social emotional competencies (self-awareness, self-management, relationship skills, responsible decision making) resulting in students' positive well being and academic success.

Parents/Guardians will:

- Send their child/children to school regularly, on time, appropriately dressed virtually (in uniform when we return in person) and prepared to learn.
- Read to/with their child/children at least fifteen (K-1) to twenty minutes (2-5) every day
- Assist their children with their homework assignments and check assignments for completion. Parent signature on homework if the classroom teacher requires it.
- Be involved in school activities by attending at least five functions during the year (Family Nights, Back to School Night, Parent-Teacher Conferences, PTA, Open House).
- Support school staff help children reach grade-level expectations.
- Reinforce SEL competencies at home resulting in students' positive well being and academic success.

Students will:

- Be respectful to others at all times.
- Dress appropriately for virtual learning. Wear uniforms daily (when we return in person).
- Complete class assignments in a timely manner.
- Always do their best and work daily towards SEL competencies and maintain a positive "Growth Mindset".

PRESIDENT – Coordinate work of officers and committees, approve all out-going letters/memos; prepare agenda and preside at all Association PTA and Board Meetings. Represent MacArthur at all Long Beach Council PTA meetings, work with Treasurer to prepare annual budget, signs checks and contracts; coordinate all PTA activities with school Principal.

VICE PRESIDENT PROGRAMS- Collaborates with principal, PTA president, and other committee chairmen to coordinate, plan and implement programs. Publicizes approved program calendar using newsletters, website, and social networks.

VICE PRESIDENT WAYS AND MEANS- Collaborates with principal, PTA president, and other committee chairmen to coordinate, plan and implement fundraisers. The primary person responsible for setting fundraising goals and organizing and implementing all fundraising activities.

RECORDING SECRETARY – Prepare and record minutes for Executive Board and Association meetings. Notify board members of any meeting changes or interim meetings scheduled by the President. Make meeting date changes available to the public per Bylaws timeline. Maintain files of official documents including the Bylaws and Annual Records.

TREASURER- Keep permanent records of all financial transactions and manage PTA funds; prepare monthly financial report and present at all PTA Association Meetings, prepare annual PTA budget, reconcile bank statements, prepare and file annual IRA tax return (using an outside agent), remit payment for dues, bills and reimbursements, prepare annual financial report. (General accounting knowledge helpful)

FINANCIAL SECRETARY – Collect, count and deposit all monies collected from all PTA events and fundraisers; handle collection of payment and fines on all NSF checks.

AUDITOR – Audit books and records of the unit semi-annually, make needed recommendations or corrections; present audit report at PTA Association Meetings in September and March; ensure the membership that the association's resources and funds are being managed in a businesslike manner within the regulations established for their use.

HISTORIAN – Assembles and preserves the record of activities and achievements of the PTA and assists the president in preparing the Annual Report; collects and report volunteer hours to Council. Photographs (or coordinates a photographer) for all PTA events.

PARLIAMENTARIAN – Attend all meetings and give advice on parliamentary procedures as needed according to Robert's Rules and the Bylaws of MacArthur PTA; keep all meetings moving in a smooth and timely matter; call meeting of the Nominating Committee; review the bylaws annually, chair the Bylaws Review Committee and formally review the Bylaws and submit to Council/State every 2-3 years. This position is appointed, not elected.

5TH GRADE COMMITTEE CHAIR – Assembles a committee of 5th grade parents in order to plan and implement 5th grade activities and graduation festivities. This position is appointed, not elected.

HOME READING CLUB CHAIR – Distributes and collects monthly home reading club logs. Coordinates monthly rewards and end of the activity for participation. This position is appointed, not elected.

HOSPITALITY CHAIR –Acts as official host of PTA in creating welcoming atmosphere at meetings and events. Works with committee and other chairman to organize and set up refreshments, food, decorations, registration, and greeters for PTA meetings and events, as needed. This position is appointed, not elected.

MEMBERSHIP CHAIR- Responsible for creating and implementing a membership plan, promoting membership throughout the year, collecting dues, and distributing membership cards. Also coordinates classroom rewards for 100% participation.

VOLUNTEER COORDINATOR- Works with the PTA president, principal and teachers to coordinate volunteer assignments at the school to support student success. Oversees volunteer recruitment, training and assignments.

- PTA association meetings- Third Tuesday of the following months September, November, January, March, and May 6:30-8:30pm
- 1-2 trainings on elected/appointed position
